Home Evaluation Report

- Receiving State has 45 calendar days to submit the final Home Evaluation Report.
- Report includes local field staff's recommendation.
- Receiving State's ICJ Office will approve or deny request for transfer of supervision.
- Check with your state's ICJ Office to learn about specific policies and procedures!

Referral Packet

The Receiving State has
45 calendar days from the
date of receipt of the
referral packet to
conduct the home
evaluation.

Mandatory Acceptance

A transfer of supervision cannot be denied when there is no legal guardian remaining in the sending state and there is a legal guardian in the receiving state.
