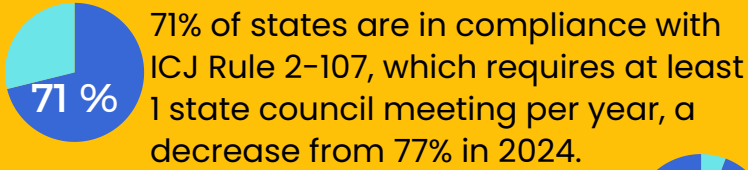




2025 State Council Report

What are the Compact's Requirements?

The Interstate Compact for Juveniles, Article IX and ICJ Rule 2-107 require states to create a state council for interstate juvenile supervision and meet at least once annually. State councils develop policies that support implementation of the Compact across agencies, including courts, detention centers, & law enforcement.

4 states reported no state council formed: **AR***, **AK**, **MA**, **NV***

3 states did not submit reports: **MT**, **NH***, **RI***
