Dear Mr. Little:

Please accept my congratulations on your recent appointment to the State Council for Interstate Juvenile Supervision. As the Compact Commissioner for the Interstate Commission for Juveniles (ICJ), I welcome you and look forward to ensuring New Jersey's compliance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 9:23B.

The role of the ICJ is to collect standardized data, monitor compliance with rules governing interstate movement of juveniles, address issues of non-compliance with the statute, and coordinate the implementation and operation of the Compact. Each member state of the ICJ is also mandated to develop and maintain a State Council. Your appointment is significant in that it demonstrates New Jersey's compliance with the Compact statute that states, "...each member state shall create a State Council for the Interstate Juvenile Supervision. ...Each State Council will advise and may exercise oversight and advocacy concerning the state's participation in Interstate Commission activities and other duties as may be determined by that state, including but not limited to, development of policy concerning operations and procedures of the compact with that state."

As New Jersey's Compact Commissioner, it is my responsibility to move forward the goals of the ICJ. Enclosed, please find NJ's State Council Mission Statement and By-Laws for your review. In the near future, you will hear from my office to coordinate a meeting of the State Council. I look forward to having your input at the table and working closely with you in this effort.
